Description: Four seasons of weed control in five bushland Reserves including two threatened ecological communities in SJ and North Murray. Includes Brickwood Reserve, Mundijong Road and Duckpond Reserves, Wright Rd Rail Reserve - Serpentine, Myara Brook - Keysbrook and North Dandalup Primary School Reserve. Includes seed collection and revegetation. Partnership project with Shire of SJ, Keysbrook Environment Group, North Dandalup Primary School and Public Transport Authority.

2.2 Peel-Harvey Rivers 2 Ramsar: Connecting River Corridors for Landscape resilience

Funding Body: Biodiversity Fund Round Two

Description: Four year \$3.4M project. Improve resilience of landscape along Harvey, Serpentine and Murray Rivers. Control animal pests and weeds; reconstruct terrestrial and aquatic habitats to reconnect corridors increasing refuge, breeding and food sources for native fauna. Landcare SJ is coordinating activities in the SJ catchment area.

2.3 Gooralong Brook restoration, Jarrahdale (stage 1 of 3) (\$15 000)

Coordinator: Vicky Kerfoot (Jarrahdale Heritage Society), with Landcare SJ assistance

Description: In partnership with National Trust of WA and Landcare SJ Inc., the intention of the project is to carry out weed control and revegetation with local native species along a 400m reach of the Brook, from the where it runs under Jarrahdale Road east to the Old Mill Manager's House, including signage.

2.5 Serpentine River Community Celebration
