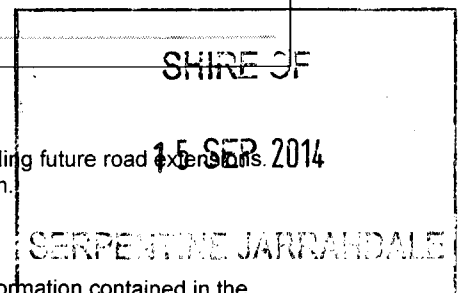

THEME FOR ROAD NAMING FOR BYFORD MEADOWS – LOT 9500 BRIGGS ROAD, BYFORD

Approval is sought for road naming theme in relation to Byford Meadows Estate on Lot 9500 Briggs Road, Byford.

The theme of equine / livestock for Lot 9500 is derived from the rich history to be celebrated in the lives of:

GANGEMI, Giuseppe & Domenica, & Family

Origin Delianuova, Pr. Reggio, Italy
Accompanying Family Assunta, Pino, Nino, Antonio & Paul
First settled in Yarloop, WA

Departure Port Messina, Italy
Arrival Year 1954

The proposed theme for the Byford Meadows Estate is centred on equine / livestock that the property had been involved with historically. Giuseppe and Domenica Gangemi were originated from Delianuova, Italy and first settled in Yarloop, WA in 1954. Their accompanying family was Assunta, Pino, Nino, Antonio and Paul.

In 1959, Giuseppe and Domenica Gangemi purchased a dairy farm in Byford WA (Lot 9500). Within 10 years, the Gangemi family became the biggest milk production quota holder in WA. They lived on the Byford farm homestead until death. Their family carried out dairying up until the year 2000. Both Giuseppe and Domenica are avid lovers of horses and livestock. And they worked the farm tirelessly putting it to good productive use.


The milestones and achievements that punctuate the rich history of the Byford farm by the Gangemi family have been significant – not only due to the ‘on the ground’ benefits to the locals, but owing to their positive impact on WA dairy milk production and social wellbeing.

In recognition of Giuseppe and Domenica Gangemi’ outstanding contributions to the Byford locality and having worked the Byford farm for over 40 years, it is fitting that the redevelopment of the
