The Serpentine Cemetery is located on the corner of South Western Highway and Gordon Road, Serpentine. The Cemetery has a number of burials and cremation options available, and the staff at the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale will assist you and your family in finding something suitable for your loved one.

History of the Cemetery

The Serpentine Cemetery was established in 1856 for the settlers in and around The Serpentine district. The district included settlements at Serpentine, Keysbrook, Mardella and Hopeland and Mundijong. The original cemetery had separate Catholic and Protestant sites. For the past fifty or so years, however, the cemetery has also become the resting place for people from outside the district and those of all religious denominations (Walk with Ancestors, Mann. W (2006)).

It is estimated that as of 2015 the availability of new plots should last approximately 4 years at current burial rates.
