

Terms and Conditions – Shire Bunting Bingo Trail Competition 2026



1. Introduction

The Shire is excited to announce the Bunting Bingo Trail, running from 5 January – 31 January 2026. Participants are invited to collect a bingo card from Byford Library, explore the Shire to find the colourful bunting, and return their completed card for a chance to win a \$20 Community Resource Centre Op Shop voucher.

By entering this competition, participants agree to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions.

2. Eligibility

The competition is open to all community members. Entrants under the age of 18 must have permission from a parent or guardian. This will be evident by the parents email address on the card.

3. Competition Period

The competition will run from **5 January to 31 January**.

All completed bingo cards must be returned to Byford Library by **3:00 PM on 31 January**.

Late submissions will not be considered.

4. How to Enter

- Participants must collect a bingo card from Byford Library and provide the required contact details (parent / guardian name & email address). This email address will be how winners are contacted.
- Participants must locate the colourful bunting displayed around the Shire.
- To enter the draw, participants must collect **three (3)** stamps from **three different locations** which are displaying the bunting.
- Completed cards must be returned to Byford Library before the competition closes.
- Only one completed bingo card may be submitted per participant.

5. Participation Guidelines

- Participants should conduct themselves safely and responsibly while exploring the Shire.
- All bunting locations are accessible from public areas; participants must not enter private property.
- The Shire's social media accounts may provide clues to assist participants; these clues are optional.

6. Draw and Winners

- Five (5) winners will be selected at random from all valid entries received.
- The draw will take place on **31 January**.
- The decision of the Promoter is final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the draw process.

7. Prizes

- Each winner will receive one prize, as determined by the Shire.
- Prizes are not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.

8. Use of Entries

By entering this competition, participants grant the Shire permission to use their names for promotional and announcement purposes relating to the competition, including but not limited to social media posts and Shire publications.

9. Notification of Winners

Winners will be notified via the email address provided on their bingo card.

- If a winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable timeframe, the Shire reserves the right to redraw the prize.
- Winners' names may be published on the Shire's website and social media platforms unless the winner requests anonymity.

- No purchase is necessary to enter the competition.
- The Shire is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, or incomplete entries.
