- An occupier of rateable property (e.g. tenant of business premises or other nonresidential property).

An "affected elector" is:

- An elector whose eligibility as an elector comes from residence, or ownership or occupation of property, in the area directly affected by the submission;
- A person who would be an elector if the area directly affected by the submission became, or became part of, a district.

Clause 3.6(g) of the Shires *Standing Orders Local Law 2002 (As Amended)* sets out the requirements for a petition to be effective:

- (g) be in the form prescribed by the Act and Local Government (Constitution) Regulations 1996 if it is
  - (i) a proposal to change the method of filling the office of President;
  - (ii) a proposal to create a new district or the boundaries of the Local Government;
  - (iii) a request for a poll on a recommended amalgamation;
  - (iv) a submission about changes to wards, the name of a district or ward or the number of councillors for a district or ward.
