We have had a few officers leave and new officers commence.

CCTV Subsidy and Cam Map

If you've considered getting CCTV for your home or business, or upgrading your existing system, check out the Shire's subsidy program to see how you can take up the opportunity to get a portion of the costs back.

One of the requirements for the program is to register your CCTV to Cam Map. This is a database that identifies your address as having a public facing camera. The database is only accessible by WA Police, who do not have access to your cameras, but can pinpoint locations and contact you if they need footage for particular incidents.

See Something, Say Something Antisocial behaviour and hooning

Hooning threatens the safety of our neighbourhoods and should not be tolerated. Reckless actions like drifting, burnouts, and speeding in public areas pose serious risks not only to the drivers, but also to passengers, pedestrians and other road users.

Although tough legislation is in place to help police address hoon driving and prevent these incidents, police often need the public's reports and information to tackle these issues.

Hoon driving can be reported immediately to 131 444 or for past incidents and additional information, online

CCTV Subsidy Program

Need a new or updated security system? The Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale has a CCTV Subsidy Program to assist with the cost of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) security systems for our community.

Eligible residents and businesses can receive a one-off payment of up to \$300 for DIY installations or up to \$500 for professionally-installed security systems. Participants in the subsidy program may use the funds to upgrade an existing CCTV system, provided they meet certain technical requirements.

Cam-Map WA

Have you heard of Cam-Map WA?

One of the requirements for the CCTV Subsidy Program is to register your public facing camera to Cam-Map WA. This is done online via their website. Cam-Map WA is a database that is only accessible by WA Police. They do not have access to the cameras directly, only a list of locations where the cameras are. This helps police rapidly identify homes or businesses which could have CCTV footage to support investigations and respond more effectively to incidents as they arise.
