Over two action packed days we saw over 1900 attendees join us in person to explore our inaugural Serpentine Jarrahdale Career And Enterprise Expo.

The Serpentine Jarrahdale Career And Enterprise Expo was designed as an opportunity for people from across the local community to connect with leading local employers as they explore the opportunities available to them in the workforce, and develop the skills required to pursue a career in their chosen field.

This report summarises the outcomes of our inaugural year, where we saw more than 1400 students, 500 community members, and 32 educators come together to see what incredible opportunities the surrounding community has to offer.









### 9:00am - 3:00pm | Community Day


This was the time that all community members could attended the expo and explore the fete outside that was put on by the Byford P&C.


### 3:00pm - 4:00pm | Bump Out
