- ringbarking of trees
- soil erosion
- poor waste management resulting increased insects
- burn pile with chemical containers
- horses reaching over property boundary destroying neighbouring flora
- poor property drainage where stock is kept
- overstocking of paddocks.

Second to the concerns highlighted in these photos, I would like the following points discussed:

- 1.Will the property owner be required to repair the current land damage?
2. How will the Shire enforce compliance going forward?
- 3.What will ensuring ongoing compliance cost ratepayers?

Additionally we are concerned that the large amounts of stagnant water that accumulate during the winter season, when combined with poor waste management, could be contaminating the ground water. Is this something that will be looked into?
