### Notice of Motion

A Notice of Motion was received from Councillor Coales via email on Monday, 7 December 2020.

The Notice of Motion is “That Council:

1. Requests the Chief Executive Officer not proceed with the Rating Equity Project to review the valuation methodology used for all properties in the Shire as outlined the project plan and communication strategy adopted by Council at the 20 July Ordinary Council Meeting.
2. Requests the Chief Executive Officer advise those properties notified of a potential change of Councils decision in regards to this matter.”

### Officer Comment

A Special Council Meeting (SCM) has been called for 1:00PM on Monday, 14 December 2020. The purpose of meeting is to consider correspondence received from the Minister for Local Government dated 8 December 2020 regarding the rating equity project adopted by Council at the 20 July 2020 Ordinary Council Meeting.

This matter is discussed in the Agenda Report for the 14 December 2020 SCM.

Depending on Council’s resolution at the SCM, the motion proposed in the Notice of Motion could constitute a revocation under Regulation 8 of the *Local Government (Administration) Regulations 1996*, be a change to the previous decision that revises some but not all of a Council’s previous resolution on the matter, or propose a course of action that has already been resolved. Further Officer advice will be available at the meeting as Council requires.
