To whom it may concern,

On behalf of the West Australian Football Commission (WAFC) I am writing to provide our support to a Regional Level oval and supporting facilities at the new Kiernan Park Recreation Precinct in the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale.

We understand that Serpentine Jarrahdale is Western Australia's fastest growing local government by a wide margin and expects its population to expand from 35,000 today to at least 113,000 by 2050.

This hypergrowth will require many additional community and sporting/recreational resources to be delivered in a timely manner. This aligns strongly with the WAFC Strategic Facilities Plan 2020 – 2030 which outlines 'partnering with government to deliver new ovals and amenities in growth areas' as a State-Wide Infrastructure Priority.
