



Local Planning Policy 4.5 Temporary Accommodation

Objectives: Place

Outcome: 2.1 - A diverse, well planned built environment.

Strategy: 2.2.1 - Develop, maintain and implement plans for the management and maintenance of Shire controlled parks, reserves and natural assets.

Purpose

1. To provide standards for temporary accommodation purposes whilst building a residence.
2. To ensure that outbuildings are not used for habitable purposes.
3. To ensure that temporary accommodation does not compromise amenity.

Policy

1. Within the Rural, Farmlet, Rural Living A and B, Special Rural, Special Residential, Special Use and Urban Development zones, lots greater than 10 000m² may have one caravan on a lot for the use of temporary accommodation for a maximum period of twelve months.
2. Temporary accommodation may be approved for a period of six months. An extension of up to six months may be considered if the construction of the single house has been substantially commenced.
3. An application for temporary accommodation must be accompanied by an application for a single house, or have an existing approval for a single house.
