#### 1. The projects

#### **Hypergrowth Road Upgrades**

Upgrades to roads, prioritised using crash data, current and future traffic volumes and classification, road condition and future growth and development in the area.

**Commitments**: \$17 million – WA Labor Party

\$17 million – WA Liberal Party

#### SJ Community Recreation Centre: expansion of vital sporting facilities

The delivery of four compliant basketball courts, additional space for other court sports and the ability to develop competition level basketball. Additionally, increased gymnasium and fitness rooms and a crèche.

**Commitments**: \$10 million – WA Labor Party

\$15 million – WA Liberal Party

#### **BMX** track relocation

Relocation of the BMX track to Keirnan Park and associated infrastructure.

Commitments: -

#### 15 New Netball Courts and Pavilion at Keirnan Park

Delivery of additional multisport facilities at Keirnan Park, Mundijong.

**Commitments**: \$40.4 million – Nationals WA

#### **Delivery of a High-Quality Tourism Facility**

Development of Jarrahdale Trails Centre as a key tourism asset for the region.

**Commitments**: \$5 million – WA Labor Party

#### **Delivery of upgraded fire station facilities**

Vital upgrades to improve safety and hygiene for bush fire volunteers.

**Commitments**: \$500,000 – WA Liberal Party


