The proposal falls within the TPS2 definition of ‘Child Minding Centre’, which is defined as follows:</b></p> <p><b>“Child Care Centre – means land and buildings used for the daily or occasional care of children in accordance with the Child Welfare (Care Centres) Regulations, 1968 (as amended) but does not include a family care centre as defined by those regulations, or an institutional home”.</b></p> <p><b>The Child-Minding Centre’ land use is a ‘SA’ land use in the ‘Residential’ zone which means, “that Council may, at its discretion, permit the use after notice of the application has been given in accordance with Clause 64 of the Deemed Provisions.”</b></p> <p><b>Council has previously approved the land use of ‘Child Minding Centre’ for the subject land</b></p>

<p><b>Comment: Planning Bulletin 72/2009 – Child Care Centres. The proposal is generally consistent with the provisions of the bulletin. The proposal is located within the Mundijong District Centre. The development has access to public transport services with a Transperth bus route on Paterson Street. This bus service is within walking distance, accessible by the existing foot path network abutting the proposed development site. A train station is also located on Paterson Street directly adjacent to, and opposite to, the subject site. This however does not function as part of the metropolitan passenger network but will do at some future point.</b></p>			

The existing foot path along Paterson Street provides infrastructure available to enable residents from the nearby catchment areas to walk to the subject site consistent with this objective of the bulletin.
