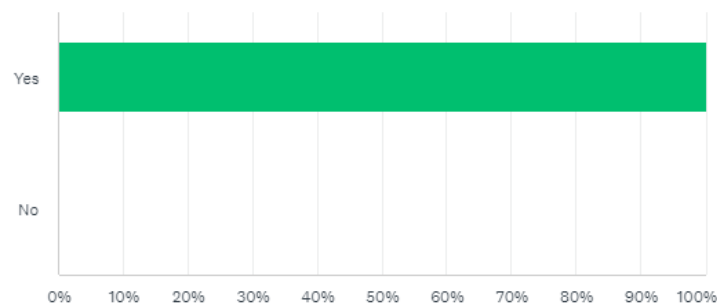


Summary of feedback survey from Anzac Day stakeholders. A total of 5 individuals completed the survey including one representative who provided valuable input but was primarily responsible for the delivery of the Jarrahdale Services, not Mundijong Services.

I spoke with Ben, the AV guy, afterwards and he said that he was told at the dawn service to just do the same at the next service. I don't understand this, or who told him, as I had said at a meeting that the band had a trumpeter who would play. I gave her name (Darelle) and this name subsequently appears in the Anzac Day Action List from the Planning Meeting Notes of 28/3/2023, although it doesn't say in what respect. I also emailed the information to Lisa on the 21/3/2023. I think it would have been a good idea if, when I was checking the final draft program, I confirmed the trumpeter and had her name added in the program too. I guess there can never be too much checking and double checking! I spoke with the Band conductor and apologised to him. It was just very unfortunate.

Whoever does the gunfire breakfast needs to be aware of the noise they make while the service is taking place.

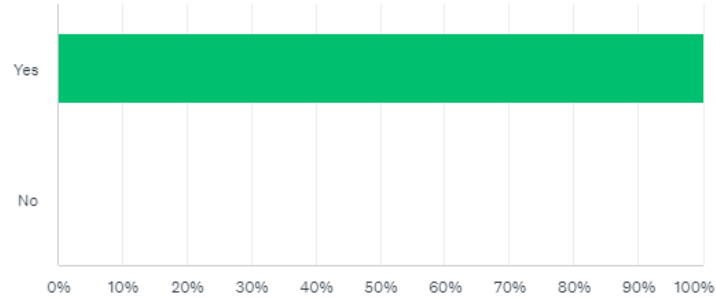

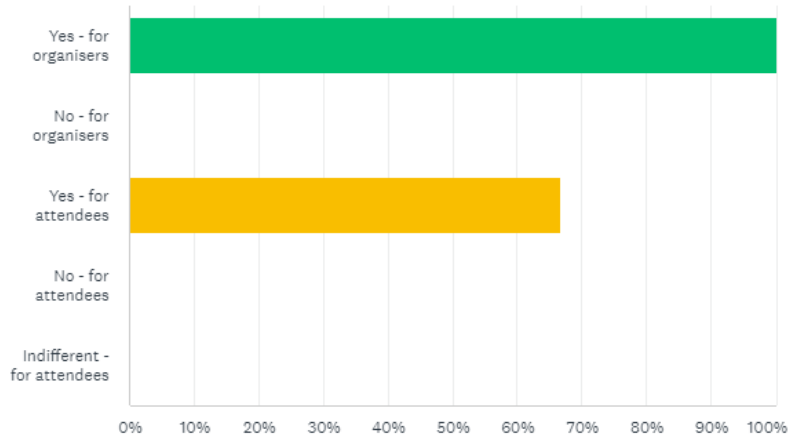

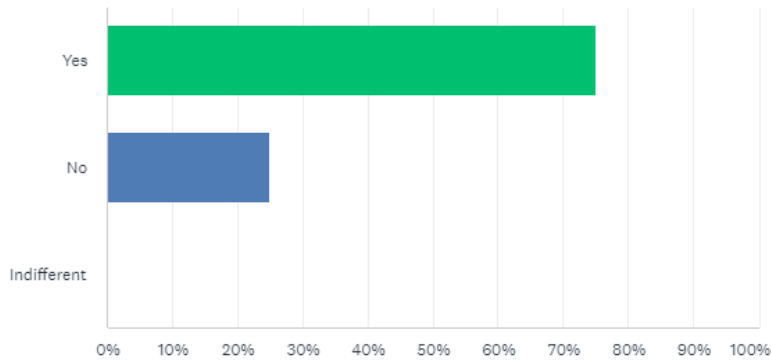

Do you support the Dawn Service and Gunfire Breakfast being delivered at the same location as the Processional March, Commemorative Service and Morning Tea every year?

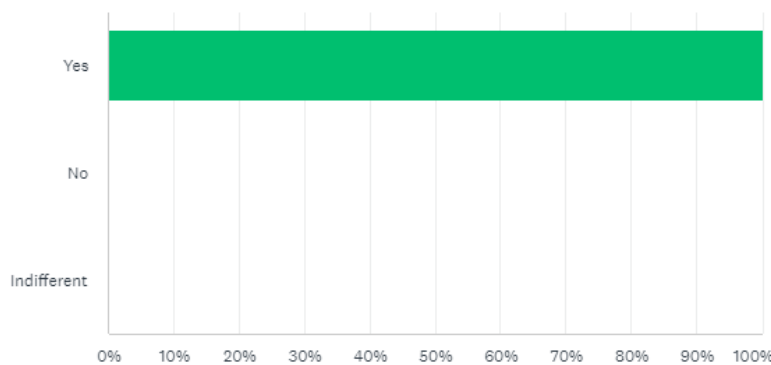

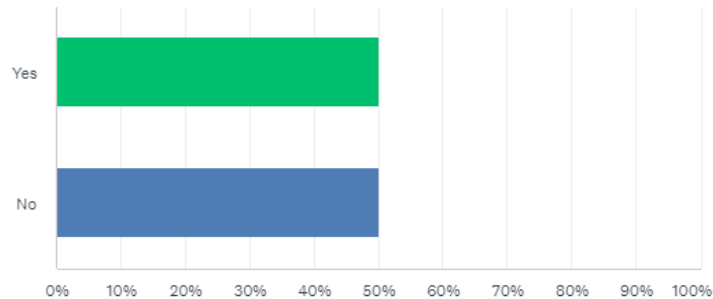
