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Hi James,

Thank you for meeting us on 9th Feb 2022 to discuss the speed zoning review process. Multiple locations were discussed in the meeting, and the list of the area is as follows:

- Area speed zoning review for Abernethy Road, Bournbrook Av, Hopland Road and Tuart Road;
- Area speed zoning review for Evelyn Street, Roman Road, Galvin Road;
- Speed zoning review of the entire Shire;
- Speed review of Summerfield Road;

It was mentioned that speed changes without supplementing infrastructure improvements would not likely have any significant impact on driver’s behaviours. It was also discussed that a consistent message across the network is crucial, and a holistic speed review of the shire network has not been undertaken. Therefore, as discussed and agreed, the Shire is to undertake a network speed limit review first, before MRAW evaluates speed limit change requests for each particular location/area. Once the network assessment has been completed and locations have been identified, the Shire is to liaise with MRWA and submit a speed limit form and other relevant documents in accordance with the MRWA speed zoning guidelines.

In regards to Summerfield Road, It is also noted that Summerfield Road currently has a reduced speed limit under the use of TMP. In order to determine an appropriate speed limit along Summerfield Road, please organise additional traffic counts after the completion of works at Karnup Road. Thank you again for coming to RNOC for the meeting.
