Proposed Cat Local Law 2023

After the Ordinary Council Meeting held in May 2022, Council requested the following information:

- 1. Council would like to know how many local governments in WA have created Cat Local Laws, and what they have dealt with. Please can you list them in table form, as follows:
 - See Metro Council Cat Local Law feature detailed below.
- 2. Council would like to see the Draft community engagement plans for both the proposed Dog and Cat Local Laws, specific to how this is planned to be done.
 - Coordinator Community Safety has provided a draft Engagement Plan.
- 3. Question 3 related to the proposed Dog Local Law
- 4. Council would like to know what implications a Cat Local Law has in respect of infrastructure spending or staff ability to deal with complaints. For example, Pound Facility cannot deal with cats.

Staff already receive complaints, with some issues able to be addressed, however as the Cat Act & Regs have no nuisance or control provisions, most complaints are managed by education, with this working some of the time, if not, the actual issue may continue,

and may also result in angry residents taking "cat control" measures to resolve the issue.

This current situation does not provide the level of service the community expects.

What cost would potentially ratepayers face if a local law progressed.

- At this time there is no additional budget costs as impound and rehoming arrangements are in place with local vets.
- With the adoption of the proposed LL, there is a likelihood that the number of impounded cats may increase, this may result in additional costs, however these are recovered through impound charges and costs.
- There is a longer-term plan to establish a "Dog and Cat Pound Facility" in the Mundijong West Industrial area, collocated with a new Operations facility.
- With the ability to issue infringement notices for issues relating to nuisance cats and containment, there could be the possibility of revenue from the implementation of the Local Law, although this is not the intent.
- 5. Council would like to know whether a Cat Local Law is required given planned Act changes.
 - That there was a draft "Cat Act Amendment" Bill, however the latest information is that the Bill will not be going to public consultation, or be presented to Parliament in the foreseeable future.
 - No timeframe has been given, but is not a priority for this Government at this time (we are likely to be talking years).
 - It is noteworthy with the imminent transition from Town Planning Scheme (TPS2) to TPS3. that current cat prohibition scheme amendments will no longer be enforceable. The proposed Cat LL carries this prohibition/restriction forward.
