At the conclusion of the 2023 Local Government Elections, a councillor from the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale North Ward (which did not go to election) was elected Shire President, creating a vacancy in the North Ward.

This means an extraordinary election needs to be conducted in the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale to fill this vacancy.

The earliest date the WA Electoral Commission (WAEC) can conduct an extraordinary election for the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale is Friday 1 March 2024. Alternatively, the WAEC can be engaged to conduct an extraordinary election on an alternative date after 1 March 2024.

Once confirmed. WAEC will contact you formally. For the avoidance of doubt, this letter does not constitute my written agreement to be responsible for the conduct of your local government election.

If you would prefer to conduct the extraordinary election in-house (i.e. run your own election), can you also please inform the WAEC of your decision in writing by mid-November 2023, WAEC will then provide you with additional information to assist you conduct your own election.
