PREVENTION NOTICE

Premises to which this notice relates (the Premises):

The Premises, the subject of this section 73A *Environmental Protection Act 1986 (the Act)* Prevention Notice (*Notice*), is situated on:

Portion of Lot 60 (No. 394) Robertson Road CARDUP, as depicted in the Indicative Plan (Appendix 2).

Reasons for which this Notice is issued:

This Notice is given because I reasonably suspect on the following grounds that waste has been discharged from the *Premises* otherwise than in accordance with a works approval, licence or requirement contained in a closure notice or an environmental protection notice and that a condition of pollution has or is likely to arise:

- a) Evidence has been gathered indicating that stormwater, that appears to be contaminated by cement materials, along with cement truck washdown water, is being discharged into an unlined basin on the *Premises* and is flowing from the *Premises* into the surrounding environment. The surrounding residential area is not connected to
- scheme water and residents rely on groundwater and rainwater for potable and nonpotable purposes.
- b) On 6 July 2023, Inspectors from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) conducted an inspection of the *Premises*, observing cement product manufacturing within the *Premises* and in particular the operation of newly constructed stressing beds situated within the western portion of the operational area. The operation of the stressing beds was observed by *Inspectors* to be emitting significant noise and vibration, causing physiological health impacts to the *Inspectors*.
- c) On 6 July 2023, an *Inspector* attended and area approximately 300 metres south of the western stressing bed of the *Premises* at the intersection of Robertson Road and Norman Road, observing significant vibration and noise of sufficient levels, likely to cause impacts to the health and amenity of occupants of adjacent *noise sensitive premises*.

- d) Evidence has been gathered to support that dust and noise emissions cause by concrete product manufacturing activities undertaken within the *Premises*, are impacting the health and amenity of adjacent noise sensitive premises.
- e) Photographs and video received by DWER, provides evidence that activities within the *Premises* are creating high amounts of dust and that dust is likely to be leaving the *Premises* boundary and impact on the health and amenity of adjacent *noise sensitive premises*.
- f) On the 14 July 2023 a noise measurement was obtained at a noise sensitive premises adjacent to the Premises by the Shire of Jarrahdale Serpentine. This measurement was in excess of assigned noise levels under Regulation 8 of the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997 for Noise sensitive premises: highly sensitive area.

I am satisfied that:

Permacast Pty Ltd is the company that has constructed and operated infrastructure, machinery, vehicles and cranes within the premises for the purpose of *manufacturing cement products* and are the appropriate person/s to give this Notice.

Requirements of this Notice:

Terms used in this Notice have the meaning defined in Appendix 1 to this Notice.

The following requirements upon the person to whom the Notice is given are considered appropriate to achieve the following results:

- A. In accordance with section 73A(2)(a) of the Act, to deal with waste (contaminated stormwater and contaminated vehicle wash water) which has been or is being discharged (Requirement 1).
- B. In accordance with section 73A(2)(b) of the Act, to prevent the condition of pollution from arising or control or abate that condition if it arises (Requirements 2 4 inclusive).

Requirements

- 1. Within six months of receiving this Notice, the persons to whom this Notice is given must ensure that the wastewater and stormwater collection drainage basin situated in the south-western corner of the *Premises*:
 - 1.1. Is lined to achieve a permeability of less than 1 x 10-9 metres per second or equivalent, and
 - 1.2. Demonstrate the drainage basin is designed to contain leachate and stormwater produced as a result of a 1:100-year storm event, and
 - 1.3. Demonstrate how the drainage basin will maintain an operational freeboard of no less than 500mm with a wet freeboard (overflow spillway outlet) at 300 mm, and
 - 1.4. Demonstrate a separation distance of at least two (2) metres shall be maintained between the maximum groundwater table elevation and the base of the drainage basin, and
 - 1.5. Provide to the *CEO* a report certified by a suitably qualified engineer confirming that the drainage basin meets the above requirements.
- 2. The persons to whom this Notice is given must not operate, or cause, or allow to be operated, any infrastructure, machinery, vehicle or crane within the *Premises* for the

purpose of *cement product manufacturing* in a manner that causes, or is likely to cause, any of the following emissions:

- 2.1. Visible dust that is likely to leave the boundary of the Premises;
- 2.2. Noise exceeding assigned levels at any adjacent *noise sensitive premises*, as determined in accordance with regulation 8 the *Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997* for *Noise sensitive premises: highly sensitive area*.
- 3. The persons to whom this Notice is given must not operate or cause, or allow to be operated, any infrastructure, machinery, vehicle or crane within the *Premises* for the purpose of *cement product manufacturing* between the hours of 6:00pm and 7:00am, except for:
 - 3.1. Transportation of completed concrete products from the *Premises* in a direct route via Robinson Road and Norman Road to South Western Highway.
- 4. The persons to whom this Notice is given must not operate, or cause, or allow to be operated, any infrastructure, machinery, vehicle or crane for the purpose of *cement product manufacturing* within the *Restricted Area* of the *Premises*, as depicted in the Indicative Plan at Appendix 2 of this Notice, unless:
 - 4.1. The persons to whom this Notice is given, provides written evidence to an *Inspector* that suitable emissions control measures have been implemented to prevent the condition of pollution from arising, and
 - 4.2. An Inspector authorises in writing that the Restricted Area no longer applies, or
 - 4.3. A licence to operate a premises prescribed under Schedule 1, Part 2, Category 77 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations* 1987, has been granted under section 57 of the *Act*.

Duration

This Notice subsists until it is cancelled by written notice from an Inspector.

Appendix 1: Definitions

In this Notice, unless the contrary intention appears -

'the Act' means the Environmental Protection Act 1986 (WA).

'Authorised person' means a person or member of a class of persons appointed under section 87(1) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*

'Cement product manufacturing' as defined under regulation 2 of the Environmental Protection (Concrete Batching and Cement Product Manufacturing) Regulations 1998 - means the manufacturing of products in which cement or concrete is the principal ingredient.

'Days' means all days including weekends and public holidays.

'the Department' means Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.

'Inspector' means a person appointed to be an inspector under section 88 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*

'Inspector' for the purposes of correspondence means;

'the Premises' refers to the Premises to which this Notice applies, as specified at the front of this Notice and depicted in the Indicative Plan (Appendix 2), and includes the portion of Lot 60 (No. 394) Robertson Road CARDUP (apart from the area subject of works approval W6658/2022/1 for concrete batching operated by WA Premix, Ransberg Pty Ltd) bounded by a line joining the GDA2020/MGA Zone 50 coordinates set out consecutively in the tables below:



Note that under section 118 of the Act that each person who is a director or who is concerned in the management of the body corporate may be taken to have also committed the same offence.

Section 103 of the Act provides that:

- a person who is aggrieved by a requirement contained in this Notice may within 21 days of being given this notice lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal; and
- any other person who disagrees with a requirement contained in this Notice may within 21 days of the making of that requirement lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal.

PENDING THE DETERMINATION OF AN APPEAL REFERRED TO ABOVE, THE RELEVANT REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS NOTICE CONTINUE TO HAVE EFFECT.
