The Presiding Member, Councillor Rich declared the meeting open at 6:34pm and welcomed members of the Public, Councillors, and Staff to the Special Meeting of Electors.

Councillor Rich acknowledged that the meeting is being held on the traditional lands of the Noongar People, and paid her respects to the Traditional Owners, Elders Past, Present and Emerging.

Councillor Rich reminded those in attendance of the requirement to wear masks, in accordance with current Public Health directions.

Councillor Rich advised that in accordance with section 5.28 of the *Local Government Act 1995*, a Special Meeting of Electors has been convened following receipt of a request in the prescribed form from not less than 100 electors in the District.

A request was received on 10 February 2022 with the purpose of the meeting requested by the electors being:

1. the effect of mandatory vaccination on electors, ratepayers, residents and businesses in the district;
2. the effect of mandatory vaccination on the local government's affairs and the performance of the local government's functions; and



3. motions to be voted on for an advocacy position against mandatory vaccination for the Council to consider adopting to provide leadership and guidance to the community in the district.

The procedures for the meeting are as specified in the Act and the *Local Government (Administration) Regulations 1996*. The legislation states that the procedure to be followed at the meeting is to be determined by the person presiding at the meeting.

The Presiding Member, Councillor Rich advised that the meeting will be conducted generally in a manner consistent with the Shire's Standing Orders.

Regulation 18 of the *Local Government (Administration) Regulations 1996* states that:

1. Each elector who is present at a general or special meeting of electors is entitled to one vote on each matter to be decided at the meeting but does not have to vote.
2. All decisions at a general or special meeting of electors are to be made by a simple majority of votes.
3. Voting at a general or special meeting of electors is to be conducted so that no voter's vote is secret.

The structure of the meeting shall be:

- Public Questions of which prior notice has been given.
- Public Questions received from the floor.
- Public Statements of which prior notice has been given.
- Public Statements received from the floor.
- Motions of which prior notice has been given.
- Motions received from the floor.

Each elector wishing to ask a question may ask a maximum of three questions related to the purpose of the meeting.

Public statements related to the purpose of the meeting must be not greater than three minutes in length.

Motions related to the purpose of the meeting may be debated with speakers for and against the motion. No speaker may speak for greater than 5 minutes regarding a motion.

The provisions related to conduct that operate in the Standing Orders are to apply. This means that each person present is to extend due courtesy and respect to all in attendance.

Electors have been provided with a voting card. When a motion is called for a vote electors are to raise the card to determine if the motion is carried or lost.

Decisions made at the electors' meeting will be considered at a future Council Meeting in accordance with legislation.

In accordance with the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale's Standing Orders it is not permitted to record the meeting.

Can we get approval to record the meeting and why is the meeting not being recorded?

Hi everyone, thanks for coming tonight to fight for freedom.

implement mandates with all the protections in place - I will go through a few of these :

- All state laws are subject to the commonwealth constitution section 109 which states when a law is inconsistent with the law of the commonwealth the state law is null and void at all times - thus all mandates are unlawful as no person has any right to ask for your private medical info except by a judge signed court order because we are protected by the privacy act and the biosecurity act.
- Australian business CANNOT be mandated by the state , they are bound by federal law at all times states cannot change workplace laws .
- Our constitution states medical conscription is illegal . It is also stated in our national immunisation program and the Nuremburg code that coerced medical treatments are illegal. These vaccines are still on trial until 2023, the Criminal Code states participation in a clinical trial must be voluntary. I strongly believe most people would consider loss of job and income would be classed as coercion, and that most WA citizens only got vaxed for this reason- this is classed as assault by law . All those complicit and involved from government officials to the nurse who gave the needle are liable for assault. If an employer thinks they are protected from prosecution because they were compelled to follow an unlawful direction they are mistaken. Following orders is not a defence in law.
- Some magistrates are stating that the public health order and state of emergency trump all other acts , but not only is this untrue because of the afore mentions section 109, but also because these must be signed by the governor general and this has not been done.
- The vaccine mandate has been issued onto workplaces and therefore the work health and safety act is also relevant legislation. Under this act all businesses are obligated under duty of care to provide a safe workplace and based off data pertaining to the safety of the vaccine, no long term data, and no material safety data sheets in existence and the fact the drug is still on trial should mean it would NEVER be implemented - the penalty for industrial manslaughter is up to 20 years.
- In actual fact all these laws are actually invalid for an even greater reason . In 1901 our commonwealth of Australia was actually sold off to the US stock market, in 1901 the "commonwealth" was changed to "the government of Australia" the



corporation illegally and without the public's knowing, and without the Queen's signature. This means every election since and laws since are all invalid.
