

All horse properties need to have a storage location for their hay. As to how large this is, depends on how many horses a person may have and how big the property is.

An ideal hay storage location would be a dry shed or stable, preferably with a cement floor, or a solid floor of some kind. Sometimes the hay is elevated from the floor to create an airflow under the bales to prevent mould from developing.

Ideally, the hay shed should have an ease of access so that loading and unloading of hay bales is easy.

You need to keep in mind that hay will often attract rodents, which in turn attracts snakes who use the rodents as a feed source.
