WASHDOWN BAYS



Generally used to "wash" horses either to keep the horse clean, to cool them off or apply water to a wound.

These can be created as indoor or outdoor bays and require several elements for safety and practicality.

These include:

- A tie up rail,
- Usually a cement floor
- Drainage, either through the slope of the cement or a piped system.
- Where the water is drained to needs to be a consideration.

This property has four wash bays, with two being inside and two being on the outside and being constructed around the shed known as "the Barn".
