WEED MANAGEMENT



Weed management is an integral part of pasture management. There are different levels of weeds, with some that we tend to live with and tolerate more than others.

This usually depends on:

- their ability to spread or their rate of spread
- ability to become an environmental weed
- whether they are toxic to livestock or
- whether they are Declared Weeds that need to be controlled under State legislation.

Locally toxic weeds include Patersons Curse, Cape Tulip and Cottonbush as follows:
